

## 16 to 19 tuition fund review 2021-22

The 16 to 19 tuition fund is a £96 million one-off fund for the 2021 to 2022 academic year only. It is ring fenced funding for schools, colleges and all other 16 to 19 providers to support small group tuition for 16 to 19 students in English, maths, and other courses where learning has been disrupted. For the academic year 2020-21, we have been allocated a one-off grant of £2,428.

Barriers to attainment:		
<b>A</b>	Achieving a grade 4 or above in GCSE maths is paramount to improving students' pathway opportunities. A small group of students did not achieve a grade 4 in their maths GCSE in 2021 due to the disruptions caused by the Covid-19 outbreak.	
<b>B</b>	Achieving a grade 4 or above in GCSE English is paramount to improving students' pathway opportunities. A small group of students did not achieve a grade 4 in their English GCSE in 2021 due to the disruptions caused by the Covid-19 outbreak.
