

16 to 19 tuition fund 2022-23

The 16 to 19 tuition fund is ring fenced funding for schools, colleges and all other 16 to 19 providers to support small group tuition for 16 to 19 students in English, maths, and other courses where learning has been disrupted. For the academic year 2022-23, we have been allocated a one-off grant of £2,470.

Barriers to attainment:		
A	Achieving a grade 4 or above in GCSE maths is paramount to improving students' pathway opportunities. A small group of students did not achieve a grade 4 in their maths GCSE in 2022.	
B	Achieving a grade 4 or above in GCSE English is paramount to improving students' pathway opportunities. A small group of students did not achieve a grade 4 in their English GCSE in 2022.
