

the 16 to 19 tuition fund 2021 to 22 academic year.

The 16 to 19 tuition fund is a £96 million one-off fund for the 2021 to 2022 academic year only. It is ring fenced funding for schools, colleges and all other 16 to 19 providers to support small group tuition for 16 to 19 students in English, maths, and other courses where learning has been disrupted. For the academic year 2020-22, we have been allocated a one-off grant of £2,428. We will use reports from our MI system to identify learners who are eligible for support, using the criteria set by the ESFA. We will review at a subject level those learners whose progress has been impacted by the effects of the pandemic. We will consider at a subject level how best to deliver small group or 1 to 1 additional support in line with student needs and available resources. We will deliver the Tuition fund small group learning using a variety of options depending on availability of resources Use existing teaching staff to deliver additional support additional tuition staff recruited to deliver additional support online tuition resources to deliver additional support
