













Salut! Ça va?



I hope that you are all well and have been enjoying the sunshine on your daily walk or cycle.

I have attached some new work to keep you busy! This bank of lessons covers colours. We have learned them in class already, so this is just some revision.

First of all, look at sheet one. Can you remember the names of colours in French? I have given you a colour coded clue! Read the words out loud first and then colour in the blobs! If you do not have a printer, then draw and colour the blobs on paper and write the word underneath.

Now for something more challenging! Do you remember when we learned how to describe the colour of our pets, we had to put the colour in a special place? Where was that? Yes, after the pet, or the

noun. So, if we are describing the colour of our clothes, where does the colour go? Yes, after the item of clothing. **Super!**

There was something else we learned too. The colour has different endings depending on the noun being described. How do we know if a noun is masculine?

Super! It has **un** in front of it. How do we know if a noun is feminine? **Très bien!**

It has **une** in front of it.

Un hamster/Un croissant/Un cahier are all masculine words as they have **un** in front of them.

Une souris/Une pomme/Une console are all feminine words as they have **une** in front of them.

So, if the word is masculine (un), the colour stays the same. If the word is feminine (une), the colour needs the letter e added to the end.

Un hamster brun

Une souris brune

Un cahier bleu

Une console bleue

But what about colours already ending in an e (rouge/orange/jaune/rose)? Yes, you remembered! They stay the same. You do not need to add an extra e. Good work everyone!

Un hamster orange

Une souris orange

Un cahier rose

Une console rose

Check out the exceptions below too!

Here's a reminder and a task for you to complete. Circle the correct colour! Answers are at the end. Bon courage! Then complete the missing colour in French.



As-tu un animal?

Note that the colour goes after the animal in French, and note how you add an -e to the colour if it is a feminine (une) word.

Exceptions: blanc = blanche violet = violette and rouge/jaune/orange/rose/marron stay the same.

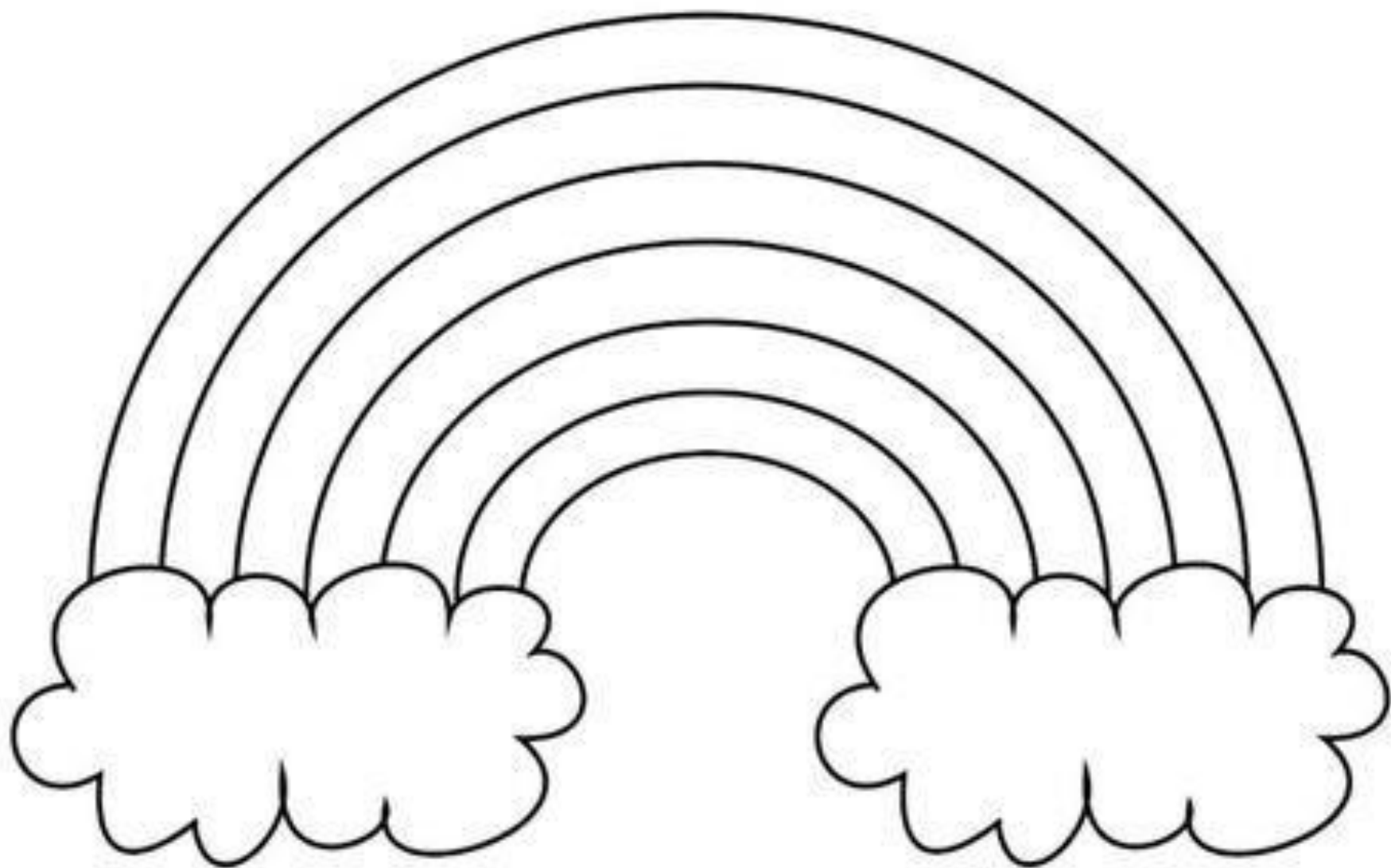
